Despite the World Health Organization (WHO) claiming that we are in the middle of a pandemic, the projects supported by the Brazilian Golf Confederation through The R&A Foundation are fully functioning. We continue to adopt monthly monitoring of our development poles, through photos, reports and student analyses.

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If the project been affected by the pandemic, please outline any adaptations you have had to make and/or the impact this will have on the delivery of the programme/project?

We are attending at regular school classes with a return well below the possibilities of measuring presence due to municipal and state health protocols; school, technical, theoretical and social performances and citizenship due to the socio-economic demands that negatively affected the families of students and their work staff - making us prioritize support actions in improving living conditions and physical health and mental; evaluations of individual and group classes, limited by very partial and late returns at school and classes with groups and playful activities of readaptation to the fundamental period in terms of careful socialization.

We believe that this is our function, to promote citizens with handicap.

We believe that, despite all the negative impacts caused by the pandemic, we are managing to overcome this challenge, as demonstrated below in each of the 6 development poles (5 cities) and their respective proven activities in 2022:

1 – Louveira, Sao Paulo - Coruja Golfe Clube

Advanced Training Groups are formed, in their majority, by the juvenile students, with more experience in the game, being that everyone already has a handicap. These groups train three times a week, an hour and a half a day. Advanced student training emphasizes the technical aspect, rules and ethics on the field, include physical training and aimed at reducing the handicap.

Intermediate Training Groups are formed by the students with golf experience and about to become handicapped. These groups train three times a week, in 1h30min training sessions. The emphasis of Intermediate Group training is on the technical aspect and the obtaining the handicap of these students. In addition to weekly training sessions, students from Intermediate and forwards participate in training on Saturdays, from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm, with the Pepê Costa Lima and Professor Regina Denadai.

The Beginner Training Groups are formed by students who train once a week for 1 hour. The students of these groups learn the basics of golf. The Beginner Families Training Group, of which part fathers/mothers and sons/daughters who are starting in Golf, trains once per week for one hour.
