



LOCAL RULES – 95th BRAZILIAN AMATEUR GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

TEE MARKERS

Men – Black Tees

Women – White Tees

PRACTICE

Rule 5.2b – Rule 5.2b is modified as follows: A player must not practice on the competition course before or between rounds.

Exception: All designated practice areas within the boundaries of the course may be used for practice on any day of the competition.

Rule 5.5b – Between the play of two holes, a player must not make any practice stroke on or near the putting green of the hole just completed or test the surface of that putting green by rubbing the green or rolling a ball.

OUT OF BOUNDS

The course is defined by boundary fences and walls, white stakes, and white dashed lines located: on the inside edge of the cart path behind the 10th tee; on the fairway side of the 18th hole; and beyond the 18th green.

DROP ZONES (ADDITIONAL RELIEF OPTION)

Holes 7, 8, 10 and 17.

PENALTY AREAS – NO PLAY ZONES

Defined by yellow or red stakes with green tops.

Note: A player or the player's caddie may retrieve a ball that is on the edge of a No Play Zone, provided this can be done without entering or stepping into the No Play Zone.

INTEGRAL OBJECTS

Wires, cables, ties or other objects closely attached to trees or other permanent objects.

Artificial retaining walls in the penalty area.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS

Defined by blue stakes and white lines.

Hole 5: The abnormal course condition (flower bed/garden) is connected to the adjacent cart path. For the purposes of Rule 16.1, both are to be treated as a single abnormal course condition.

TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (TIOs)

Advertising boards. Relief is available when there is physical interference or interference on the player's line of play.
